





Designing Tidbits:

Heres a little tip about re-coloring my textured doodles! If you would like to keep the paint stroke texture intact then you have to recolor using the "Adjust Color" tool. That is Ctrl + U for Photoshop users.

Simply make painted doodle your active layer and then hit CTRL and U at the same time. The adjust hue/saturation window will pop up and you can play with the sliders until the right color combination comes up. If you are starting with a white doodle, remember you are going to have to slide the lightness bar down some so that the color can show. Click colorize and then slide the hue slider both ways to see what works.

It takes a bit of experimenting but you are sure to love the results!


