Here is what Kirsty says about herself:



CUSTOMER SCRAPLIGHT








Do you ever envy



I'm telling you most of the time I have no desire to be a little person who doesn't get to call the shots and who is told what and when to eat, what they can and can't do, and when to go to bed - But I have to be honest, when I saw my little man sacked out in his bed like this – just sprawled out fast asleep like he had no cares in the world – I couldn't help but feel jealous. What a great feeling that must be, to just crash into bed and fall asleep worry free.

I think maybe that is the number one disadvantage we grownups are at in this world- always thinking stressing worrying. I know I'm guilty of rarely just letting myself go



Maybe tonight I can make myself do it! Climb into bed and really just sleep, not thinking about what I should have done that day, or where I am going what I need to do tomorrow, but maybe I'll just Sack out in a pure sleepy toddler kind of way!

PAPER DOODLES! So out of love of all things doodle, I thought I would share with everyone a cool tip inspired by a technique I see my awesome CT member Kristin using. Paper doodles are all the rage right now, and it is no surprise! They are fun, they are cute, and they give an extra punch to your everyday doodle.




The Fist step is to open up the doodle you would like to put on a paper backing. For this project I chose a car doodle from my new set "Boy Doodles: Planes Trains and Automobiles".

After your doodle is open, put a background layer behind it so it is easy to see, and create an extra layer directly below the doodle layer. Then hold down your ctrl button, and click on the icon for the doodle layer. Now your doodle should be selected (surrounded by the marching ants) but the blank layer below the doodle layer should be the active layer.



Now you want to add a stroke to your selection. In PSE it is found under Edit - Stroke and then it will bring up the stroke dialogue. You want to choose a slightly off white color for your stroke, and make sure you choose location "center" so that it makes the stroke go all the way up to your doodle line. If you are working in a full sized doodle



When you've finished stroking your doodle it will look

like this. All that is left to do is to fill in the clear spaces inside of doodle, the easiest way


to do this, is make sure you are still working with your stroked layer, and choose the brush tool,

pick a hard round brush, big enough to make coloring

in easy, but small enough to not go outside of the outer edge of the white doodle stroke. Then choose the same off white color as your stroke is and simply color in your doodle.

Then once you are colored in you are nearly done, just

merge your doodle layer down onto your stroke layer, and viola, your doodle is on a cut out piece of paper! Add your doodle to your layout, and if you'd like add a really slight low shadow



to it to give it a bit more dimension!
